In the year 2000, 1.1 billion people did not have access to an improved water supply.

2.4 million did not have access to improved sanitation.

19 out of 20 Liberians didn't wash their hands after going to the toilet.

In 2004, 27% of the population had access to sanitation facilities, whilst 61% had access to improved water sources.

By 2009, 45% had access to sanitation facilities, whilst 75% had access to improved water sources.
